



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS AND GUESTS

Members and guests play a crucial role in the friendly and welcoming atmosphere that we expect at ODCC.

All members and guests of ODCC will:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person.
- Treat everyone equally and not discriminate on the grounds of age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, nationality, colour, parental or marital status, religious belief, class or social background, sexual preference, political belief or for any other reason.
- Not condone, or allow to go unchallenged, any form of discrimination if witnessed.
- Display high standards of behaviour at all times.
- Place the well-being and safety of young people and adults as priority.
- Ensure that behaviours at the club are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience of the individuals around.
- Not drink and drive or drive under the influence of drugs.
- Not smoke, vape or use banned substances whilst around young people at the club.
- Not provide young people with alcohol when they are under the care of the club.
- Follow ECB guidelines set out in the "Safe Hands Policy any other relevant guidelines issued.
- Report any concerns in relation to a young person or adult, following reporting procedures laid down by ODCC.
- Respect a young person or adults' opinion when making decisions during their participation in cricket
- Respect the decisions of match officials if watching a match at the club.
- Recognise good performance and be encouraging and supportive of all players if watching a match at the club.
